As a theatrical storyteller, Arianna enchants the audience with dramatic tales spun from the rich histories, folk tales, dances and music of the far away lands where she has lived. Leeny Del Seamonds, a Master Story Performer, said "From the moment [Arianna] stepped on stage, [Arianna] captivated and engaged the audience with [her] poised and powerful presence, transporting them to a foreign—and precarious—land, while hanging on [her] every word to see what unfolded next. It was indeed a riveting story, and [she] did it justice."

Arianna worked for three years with Bansi Kaul's troupe, Rang Vidushak in Bhopal, India. There she assisted the troupe in developing sustainable arts education for children living in poverty. Based on her work as a storyteller and teacher for organizations in India, Brazil and Vietnam, Arianna founded Story Tapestries. Since returning home she has performed and taught workshops across the United States, Canada and Brazil in schools, community centers and hospitals.

Arianna has performed worldwide. Performances include: the National School of Drama Festival in Delhi, India; the International Storytelling Festival in Vancouver, BC; the Fairfax County International Children's Festival at Wolf Trap; the Washington Storyteller's Theatre; a Vietnamese School for the Deaf in Qui Nhon, Vietnam; and a School for Alternative Learning in Cork, Ireland. She has been featured on National Public Radio on the Kojo Nnamdi Show and in Public Television as a professional storyteller. She was on the board of the Healing Story Alliance, a special interest group of the National Storytelling Network, She is co-founder of Open Circle Theatre, a theatre featuring actors with a variety of learning and physical disabilities and serves on its board. She is a member of the American Alliance for Theatre and Education and the National Storytelling Network.
